

HAMILTON'S WORKING WATERFRONT:


PORT OF HAMILTON ECONOMIC IMPACT STUDY - SUMMARY

The Port of Hamilton is a key economic engine in Hamilton, and across Ontario. As the largest Canadian port on the Great Lakes system, the Port of Hamilton receives approximately 600 vessel calls per year, handling large volumes of minerals, coal, fuel, agricultural and other products.

Conducted by CPCS, the Port of Hamilton Economic Impact Study measured the economic and employment impacts of the on-site activities at the Port of Hamilton, and the value of the cargo shipped through Hamilton by vessel.

EMPLOYMENT

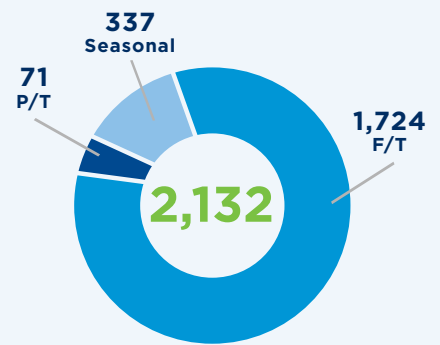
On-site employment at the Port of Hamilton has grown **30%** since 2009

in labour income is pumped back into the local economy each year through personal spending.

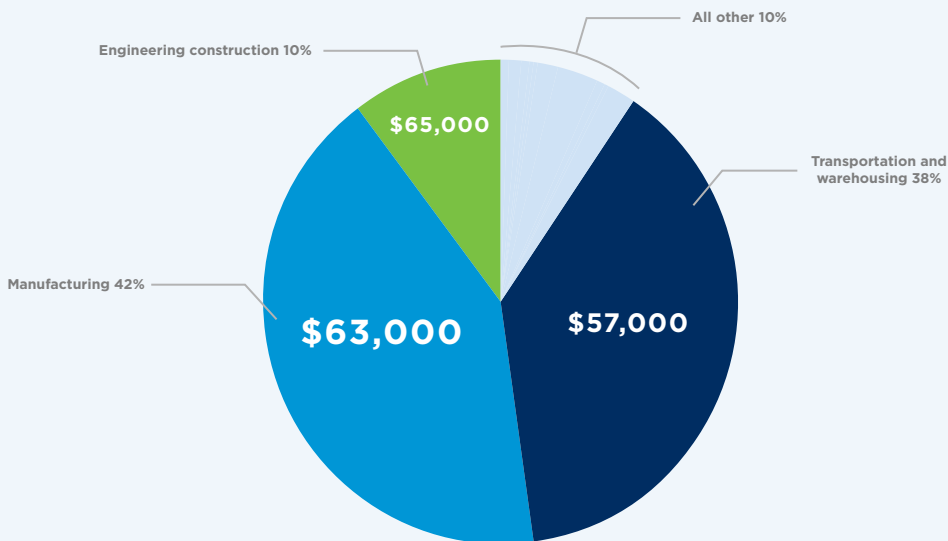

PORT JOBS ARE GOOD JOBS

Jobs at the Port of Hamilton are concentrated in high-paying fields: engineering/construction, manufacturing, and transportation/warehousing.
